LENTEN DEVOTION

Starting Feb. 22

Oftentimes, a person reads a book to discover answers. What if you invested a few minutes a day throughout Lent, using a devotional so that you could dwell longer in questions?

Jesus uses questions throughout the gospels to change lives and deepen the discipleship of those who follow him.

- What are you looking for?
- Where is your faith?
- Who do you say that I am?
- What do you want me to do for you?
- Do you love me?
- How will you believe what I say?
- Whom are you looking for?

Questions like these will encourage and challenge you to examine your priorities and faith, consider who Christ is, define and articulate your beliefs about faith and life and grow as a follower of Jesus.

Beyond Question is a daily devotional that provides a question rooted in a gospel text along with a connecting piece of "Biblical Wisdom", a "Transformative Thought", a "Psalm Fragment", "Questions to Ponder" and a "Prayer for Today". You may choose to use Beyond Question on your own, but it will likely become much more meaningful by gathering with a small group once a week. The Church has always found it necessary to consider questions together and although each of us has a personal relationship with God, we all share in One grace, mercy and love. What does that mean? (There's another great question!)
