At our Annual Meeting and Potluck on Sunday, February 12, at 11:45am, downstairs in the Fellowship Hall. you will have an opportunity to vote for amending our constitution to reflect the changes adopted in August at the 2016 ELCA churchwide assembly in New Orleans. The primary changes in the ELCA Model Constitution as stated from the Secretary of the ELCA, Rev. Wm. Chris Boerger, relate to the merging of the three lay rosters into a Roster of Ministers of Word and Service. Pastor Boerger recommends that these provisions should be added to each congregation's constitution even if the congregation does not have under call a person on one of the lay rosters.
